the Comynary Gent^l: hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the estate of David Brown late dec^d wherein it is found that there is ball^d due to the abovesaid orphans the sum of eighty three pounds, twelve shillings and five p^{ce} Court money if therefore the abovesaid James Anderson, Woney Macclenney and Richard Knight their heirs Ex^{ors} adm^{rs} or any or either of them do ^{shall} and well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the afd^d orphans the afd^d sum of eighty three pounds twelve shillings and five pence Court money in equal parts and portions according to act of assembly when they shall arrive at full age to receive the same &c. Then the above obligation to be void of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue &c.
