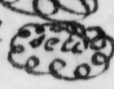
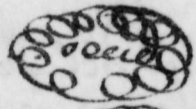

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Comynsary Gent^l hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the estate of Peter Carvey dec^d. wherein it is found that there is bal^d. due to the above said orphans the sum of thirty five pounds seventeen shillings and one half penny Court money if therefore the abovesaid William Carvey Sam^l.
