Anno Domini 1738.

Commissary General hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the
Estate of James Hogg dec'd whereupon it is found that there is balance due
to the above named orphan the sum of two pounds five shillings Current money
therefore if the above named Sarah Forsyth John Bishop and Thomas
Collins their heirs Exec adms shall and do well and truly pay or cause
to be paid unto the above named orphan the aforesaid sum of two pounds five
shillings Current money according to act of assembly and the dec'd will when he
shall arrive at full age to receive the same &c Then the above obligation
