ly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 21st Day of June
Anne D^o 1738.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the
Commissary Genl^l hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the
Estate of James Hogg dec^d. wherein it is found that there is balance due
to the abovesaid orphan the sum of two pounds five shillings Court money
therefore if the abovesaid Sarah Forsith John Bishop and Thomas
Collins their heirs Ex^{ors} or adm^{ors} shall and do well and truly pay or cause
to be paid unto the abovesaid orphan the afd. sum of two pounds five
shillings Court money according to act of assembly and the dec^d. will when he
shall arrive at full age to receive the same &c. Then the above obligation
to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue &c.
