contented but the sume to him to pay hitherto hath altogether refused  
and still doth refuse altho' thereto afterwards to witt on the second  
day of January in the year last as at the County as and often  
since that time by the said Duncan required Whereupon the said  
Duncan says he to dammifyed ten pounds curr. money of Maryland  
and thereof he brings suit vs. I Bledges & John Doe & Roe.

At whiche day here before his Lordships Justices at Court then held at Dividung  
 Creek came the ssd Duncan Murray by his attorney as and the Sheriff of Somerset  
 County to wit John Henry Gents. now here returned that he had taken the afo<sup>r</sup> Charles  
 Rankife whosbody here at this day he had ready to answer the afo<sup>r</sup> Duncan of the  
 afo<sup>r</sup> plea as to him it was commanded and further the same Sheriff returned that he  
 had served the same Charles Rankife with a copy of the declaration afo<sup>r</sup> according  
 to act of assembly in such case provided. Whereupon came hereto Court before  
 the afo<sup>r</sup> Justices aforesaid John Bowen of Somerset County planter in his proper person  
 and undertook for the afo<sup>r</sup> Charles Rankife and assumed upon himself Likewise the same  
 Charles Rankife present herein court assumed upon himself that if it should happen  
 that Judgment in the plea afo<sup>r</sup> should be rendered for the same Duncan against him the  
 said Charles Rankife or that the same Charles should be thrown into prison that then he the  
 said Charles should pay and satisfy unto the said Duncan the Judgment of the Court
