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promises beyond his costs and charges by him about his Suit in that part appeared to four pounds ten Shillings and not more and because the said Abraham denies not this but the same allegation believes to be true prays Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his costs and charges and to him to be adjudged the

Therefore by consent of the parties It is considered that the said Abraham Outen recover against the said Richard Hubbard his damages and to the said four pounds ten Shillings by the same Richard in form aforesaid acknowledged as also four hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges and to the same Abraham at his request by the Court now here of the parties and adjudged and the said debt in money &c. afterwards to wit the Twentieth day of June and the said one thousand seven hundred & thirty eight came here into Court the said Richard Hubbard in his proper person and whereupon the same Richard is committed to the prison of the House of Correction to remain until the said Abraham Outen of the damages costs and charges and be thereof fully satisfied &c.
