Which being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had -

Therefore it is considered that the afo^d sum of four pounds ten shillings current money of Maryland by the arbitrators afo^d found be condemned in the hands of the said John Evans as of the right and creditt of the afo^d Thomas Gray towards satisfying unto the said William McGummey his debt due from the said Gray also it is considered that the said William McGummey recover against the afo^d John Evans Two hundred & eighteen pounds of tobacco.
