Last November term (according to the form of the Statute in that case lately made and provided) did submit a certain matter in the said Court depending between them by means of his Lordships writ of attachment levied at the suit of the said William M^{rs} Kemney against the said Thomas Gray's goods in the hands of the said John Evans as garnishee of the said Thomas Gray and we having pursuant to such submission taken upon us the determination of the premises do award that the said John Evans do pay to the said William M^{rs} Kemney the sum of four pounds ten shillings current money of Maryland and the full expenses of suit of the said William from the date of the original writ to the finishing of the said suit to be ascertained by the taxation of the Clerk of Somerset County Court Witness our hands this fifteenth day of March Anno Domini seven hundred thirty and six - Geo: Douglas Rob^t: Jenkins Henry -

Which being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had.

Therefore it is considered that the said sum of four pounds ten shillings current money of Maryland by the arbitrators aforesaid be condemned in the hands of the said John Evans as of the right and credit of the said Thomas Gray towards satisfying unto the said William M^{rs} Kemney his debt due from the said Gray also it is considered that the said William M^{rs} Kemney recover against the aforesaid John Evans Two hundred & Eighteen pounds of Tobo.
