The a/s. Abraham deny not this but the same allegations believes to be true prays Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges a/s. to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties a/s. it is Considered that the a/s. Abraham Gullett recover, against the a/s. Worship Macclennney his damages a/s. to the a/s. three pounds twelve shillings and three pence Court money of Maryland by the same Worship Macclennney in form a/s. acknowledged; as also:
