Att which day here before His Lordships Justices at a Court then held at Devonshire (read) came the case Abraham Gullett by his attorney afo. and the sherriffe of Somerset County to witt John Henry Gent now here returned that he had taken the afo.

Worship Macclenney whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the afo. Abraham Gullett of the afo. plea as to him it was Commaided. And the afo. Worship

Macclenney in his proper person Commaided defend the force and Injury when &c. And ~~after the said~~ deny the allegation of the afo. Abraham

Abraham Gullett ~~probat~~ that he did assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the afo. Abraham above against him hath Complaind and as to the damage of the said Abraham by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Worship saith and acknowledgeth that the afo. Abraham hath sustained damages by occasion of the premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part appoyed to three pounds twelve and three pence Court money of Maryland and no more and because.

The afo. Abraham deny not this but the same allegations belives to be true prays Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges afo. to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties afo. it is considered that the afo. Abraham Gullett recover, against the afo. Worship Macclenney his damages afo. to the afo. three pounds twelve shillings and three pence Court money of Maryland by the same Worship Macclenney in form afo. acknowledged: and also:
