

Court of Somerset to be held at deviding Creek in the same County
 the third Tuesday of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred
 and thirty seven to answer unto John Bishop the son of Henry
 Bishop of a plea that he render unto him one hundred pounds
 Court money of Maryland of the said province which to him
 he owes and unjustly detains &c. And the same day is given to the same
 John Bishop here &c. and hereupon the said John Bishop declared against the
 aforesaid Donnick Dennis in the plea aforesaid in form following
 Somerset County s. Donnick Dennis late of Somerset County in the province of Maryland
 planter at. Dick Donick Dennis Junior of Somerset and province aforesaid planter
 was summoned to answer unto John Bishop the son of Henry Bishop of a plea
 that he render unto him one hundred pounds Court money of the said Province
 which to him he owes and unjustly detains &c.

And whereupon the said John by Francis Allen his attorney saith
 that whereas the said Donnick the nineteenth day of January Anno Domini
 seventeen hundred and thirty three at the County of Somerset aforesaid within the
 Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain writing obligatory which the said John with
 the seal of the said Donnick signed here into Court brings the date whereof is the
 same day and year did acknowledge himself to be bound unto the said John in
 the aforesaid one hundred pounds to be paid unto the said John when he should be
 thereunto requested yett the said Donnick tho' often required the said one
 hundred pounds to the said John hath not rendered but the same to him hitherto
 hitherto to render hath denied and still doth deny and unjustly detain to the
 Damage of the said John of fifteen pounds Court money aforesaid and thereupon
