 pray further leave thereof to dispense herewith the next Court to be held at
 Dividing Creek, the third Tuesday of March then next following and he hath it
 and the same day is given to the aforesaid William here also &c.

All which day here came again as well the aforesaid John Dennis Jnd^d as the
 aforesaid William Melvin by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the same
 William Melvin pray further leave thereof to dispense herewith the next
 Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next
 following and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Dennis Jnd^d
 here also &c. At which day here came again as well the aforesaid John Dennis
 Jnd^d as the aforesaid William Melvin by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the same
 William as before defendeth the force & injury whereof &c and saith that he is no manner
 of way guilty of the premises by the plaintiffs declaration upon him imposed and of
 him he putteth himself upon the Country and the aforesaid John in Lickemanside —

And the aforesaid William according to the Statute and with the leave of the Court —
 further saith that the aforesaid John his action aforesaid against him to have and maintain
 ought not because he saith that at the time of the making of the contract
 and agreement in the aforesaid declaration mentioned he was an infant under the
 age of Twenty one years and this he is ready to verify wherefore he prayeth judgment
 if the aforesaid John his action aforesaid against him to have ought for

And as to the second matter by the said William above in Court pleaded
 the said John protesting that he the said William at the time of the promise aforesaid
 in the declaration aforesaid mentioned was of the full age of Twenty One years for he says
 that he by any thing by the said William in his plea aforesaid precluded from having
 and maintaining his action aforesaid against the said William Ought not to be precluded
 because he saith that before and at the time of the promise aforesaid by the said William
 in the declaration aforesaid supposed to be made he the said William to work on Board
 of Ships, Shops, and other Vessels for hire and reward thereby to gain himself
 Newfany
