before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the County on the third Tuesday of August and Dated Three thousand Seven hundred and Thirty seven to answer unto Henry Reynolds in a plea of trespass upon the said Case &c and the same day is given to the afo Henry to appear

at which day here came the afo Henry Reynolds by Robert Parker his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit John Henry Gentleman at the said day here returned that he had taken the afo William Carter whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the afo Henry Reynolds of the afo plea as to him it was commended. Whereupon at the prayer of the afo Henry Reynolds the afo William Carter is by the Court here adjudged to give Special Bail to the action afo. Thereupon the said William Carter present herein Court in his proper person affirmed upon himself Likewise after him William Turpin of Somerset County Gentleman present herein Court in his proper person affirmed upon himself and made good for the same William Carter that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea afo should be rendered for the same Henry against him the said William or that the said William should be therein confined, that then he the said William should pay and satisfy unto the same Henry the Judgment of the Court thereupon or under his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of the County afo thereto remaine until the same Judgment should be fully satisfied or that he the same William Turpin will do the same for him. And hereupon the said William Carter hath in his place and stead George Douglas Gentleman attorney at Law against the afo Henry in the plea afo. Whereupon at the request of the parties afo day is given to them now here be fore his Lordships Justices at Dividing Creek until the third Tuesday of November then next following in the same State as at present claiming to the parties afo. At which day here came againe the parties afo by their attorney afo and hereupon the said Henry Reynolds declared against the said William Carter.
