And Whereupon the same Henry by Robert Derrick his attorney complains that whereas the afo^d William after the first day of
May seventeen hundred and five (to wit) the twenty eighth day of March
in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred thirty and five
at the afo^d County of Somerset within the Jurisdiction of this Court made
his certain note in writing called a promissory note with his proper hand
thereunto subscribed bearing date the same day and year last above
mentioned and the same note then and ^{there} to the said Henry Reynolds did
deliver and by the said note did promise to pay to the afo^d Henry by
the name of Henry Reynolds the sum of five pounds in either comor
pounds upon demand by reason of which said premises and also by
virtue of the Statute in such case thereof made and provided the
same William became chargeable to pay to the said Henry Reynolds
the afo^d sum of five pounds in corn or pork upon demand according to
the tenor of the note afo^d and the same William so thereof chargeable being
in Consideration thereof afterwards (to wit) the same day and year last
above mentioned at Somerset County afo^d upon himself did afo^d
signe and to the same Henry Reynolds then and there faithfully pro
mise that he the said William the afo^d five pound in corn or pork upon
Demand to the same Henry Reynolds he would well and faithfully
pay and content Nevertheless the afo^d William his promise an
assumption afo^d in form afo^d made little regarding but intending and
fraudulently intending the same Henry in this part craftily and subtily
to deceive and defraud the said sum of five pounds in corn or pork or any part
thereof to the same Henry Reynolds he hath not paid nor given for the
same in any way contented altho^t the same to be the afo^d William often
