 ing of the writing obligatory and it is read to him in these words The condition of this obligation is -
 such that if the above bounded William Gray his ^{heirs} Executors administrators or assigns shall well and
 and truly pay or cause to be paid to the above named Jaiah Bredell his heirs Executors or administrators
 the sum of thirty six pounds of bill of credit of the said province of aforesaid on demand without fraud
 or further delay then this obligation to be void and of none effect or else to stand and remain in full
 force and vertue which being read and heard the said William Gray that the said Jaiah his
 action aforesaid against him to have and maintain ought not because he says that he the said William
 on the twenty eighth day of June Anno Domini seventeen hundred thirty and four at Somerset
 County aforesaid did pay to the said Jaiah the said sum of thirty six pounds Curr money of Maryland
 in the condition aforesaid mentioned according to the force form and effect of the said condition and
 this he is ready to verify Wherefore he prays Judgment if the said Jaiah, his action aforesaid against
 him the said William to have and maintain ought &c. Whereupon the aff William Relinquish-
 eth his verification aforesaid by him above pretended, saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aff Jaiah
 nor but that the writing obligatory aforesaid is his deed, nor but that he oweth the same Jaiah the aff Seventy
 pounds Curr money of Maryland in manner and form as the aff Jaiah first above against him
 Declared -- Therefore it is Considered that the aff Jaiah Bredell recover against the aff William

Gray his debt aforesaid and his damages by occasion of the detention of that same debt to
 712 Court here adjudged and the aff William to pay ^{pounds of tobacco to the same Jaiah of his spent by the} ~~the~~ ^{with stay of execution until the first day}
 the same then next following.
