 satisfied yett as to four pounds one shilling and seven pence Residue of the aforesaid five pounds
 one shilling and seven pence the said William his promise and assumption aforesaid in form aforesaid made
 nothing regarding but plotting and fraudulently intending the said Isaac in that part
 craftily and Subtily to deceive and defraud the said four pounds one shilling and seven pence to
 the said Isaac altho the same to do the said William by the said Isaac on the aforesaid first day
 of August in the year aforesaid and often afterwards at the County of Somerset he was thereunto
 requested hath not paid or Contented but the same to him hitherto to pay hath refused and still
 doth refuse and deny to the damage of the said Isaac of eight pounds money aforesaid and thereupon he
