 his attorney and the sherriffe of Somerset County to witt John Henry Gent  
 now here returned that he had taken that he had taken the aforesaid Thomas  
 Watkins whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the aforesaid  
 Richard of the aforesaid plea as to him it was commanded. —

Whereupon the aforesaid Thomas Watkins by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney came and defended the  
 force and injury whereof and thereupon the said Richard Gildart then and there his writ against the  
 the aforesaid Thomas Watkins did not prosecute with Effect but voluntarily suffered his suit to be discontinued &c.  
 Therefore afterwards to witt that same day by direction of the Justices  
 here were adjudged the same Thomas Watkins:
