 afo<sup>r</sup> Foster there &c. At which day here before His Lordships Justices  
 at a Court then held at deviding Creech came the afo<sup>r</sup> Foster Cunliffe by  
 William Goldborough his attorney and the sherriffe of Somerset County  
 to wit John Henry Gent. now here returned that he had taken the afo<sup>r</sup>  
 Mathew Kemp whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer unto  
 the afo<sup>r</sup> Foster of the afo<sup>r</sup> pleas to him it was Commanded.

Whereupon the afo<sup>r</sup> Mathew Kemp in his proper person comes and  
 defends the force and Injury when &c. and thereupon the said Foster

 not prosecute with effectt but volentarily suffered his suit to be discon-

 Calmour and that the afo<sup>r</sup> Mathew Kemp goe thereof without day &c.
