part thereof to the said Russell did not pay and the same tobacco or any  
part thereof the said Israel and Esther or either of them since the death of the  
said Harristoy to the said Russell have not paid but the same to pay at large:  
they have refused and still doth refuse altho' that to see the said Harristoy  
in his life time afterwards to with the day and year as at the County as  
and often afterwards and the said Israel and Esther afterwards to with on  
the third day of May Anno Domini MDCCXXXVI at the County as and  
often since that time by the said John Russell were severally required where-  
upon the said John Russell says he is damaged four thousand pounds  
of tobacco and thereof he brings suit &c. — Pledges J. Doe: & Roe
