Joseph there &c. At which day here came the said Joseph Maclester for his proper  
person and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit John Harry Gents. at the same day has returned that  
he had taken the said Anthony Taylor whose body he had had ready to satisfy the said Joseph Maclester  
:ter of the Debt & Damages aforesaid as aforesaid he was commanded &c.
