County planter otherwise called Alexander Thomas of Somerset
County if he should be found in his bailiwicks and him should safe-
keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of His
Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Devidung Creek in
the same County the third Tuesday of of June Anno ^{Domini} one thousand
seven hundred and thirty eight to satisfy Joseph Macclester
as well a certain debt of seventeen hundred and thirty two pounds
of good sound tobacco which the same Joseph in his Lordships
County Court of Somerset at Devidung Creek before the Justices
thereof recovered against his him as of one hundred and ninety
four pounds of tobacco which to the same Joseph Macclester
in our same Court were adjudged for his damages which he had
by occasion of the detention of that same debt whereof he is Compt
and the same day is given to the aforesaid Joseph there &c.
At which day here came the said Joseph Macclester in his proper
person and the sherriffe of Somerset County to with John Henry Gent.
at the same day here returned that he had taken the aforesaid Alexander
Thomas whose body he had ready to ~~the~~ satisfy the aforesaid Joseph Maccles-
ter of the Debt and damages aforesaid as aforesaid he was Comanded &c.
YOU Alexander Thomas and John Hopkuis do Confess Judgment
to Joseph Macclester for the sum of uneteen hundred and twenty
six pounds of good sound tobacco which sum was recovered by the
said Joseph Macclester against Alexander Thomas on the thirteenth
day of June before George Dashiell and Thomas Williams the said
thirteen hundred and twenty six pounds of tobacco to be levied of your
bodies goods or Chattels Lands or tenements for the use of the said Joseph
Macclester in case the said Alexander Thomas shall not pay and ^{satisfie}
