Command was given to the sherriffe

of Somerset County that he should take
Littleton, Townsend if he should be found in his
Baileywick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body
before the Justices of His Lordships County Court of Somerset to be
held at Weidung Creek in the same County the third tuesday of June

And Done one thousand seven hundred and thirtieight to satisfy
Richard Gildart Esq^r of seven thousand four hundred and eleven
pounds of tobacco which sum the said Littleton Townsend Joseph Mackles-
ter and Francis Porter before Robert King and John Scott Gentlemen
two of his Lordships Justices of the peace to keep assigned down
the twenty ninth day of July And Done one thousand seven hundred
and thirtysseven by Judgment to the said Richard Gildart Esq^r with
twenty two pounds of tobacco additionall Costs according to act of assem-
bly in such case made and provided whereof he is convicted &c. and the same
day is given to the afo^r Richard there &c.

At which day came here as well the afo^r Richard Gildart in his proper
person as the afo^r Littleton Townsend in his proper person and the said
Littleton being by the afo^r sherriffe Led to the Barn by vertue of the
writ afo^r to him thereof directed and being by the Court here asked if he
was the very same Littleton the same person which the afo^r Richard of
the tobacco afo^r was convicted or not who says that he is. Therefore the
same Littleton Townsend is committed to the prison of the sherriffe of the
County afo^r there to remain in safe custody untill the same Richard of the
tobacco afo^r should be fully satisfied and paid &c.
