

same William Gray present herein Court in his proper person assumed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea aforesaid in the same Court should be rendered for the same Isaiah Bredell against him the said William Gray or that he the said William Gray should be therein convicted that then he the said William Gray should pay and Satisfie unto the aforesaid Isaiah Bredell the Judgment of the Court thereupon or Render his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of the County aforesaid thereto remain untill the same Judgment be satisfied unto the same Isaiah Bredell or that he the said George Dashiell will do the same for him.

And the aforesaid William Gray by George Douglas his attorney Cometh and Saving to himselfe all and all manner of advantages & Exceptions as well to the writ as the Narration aforesaid prayeth Liberty hereof to Imparle hereuntille the third Tuesday of November then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Isaiah here also &c.

All which day here came againe as well the aforesaid Isaiah Bredell as the aforesaid William Gray by their attorney aforesaid and whereupon the same William Saving to himselfe all and all manner of advantages and Exceptions as well to the writ as the Narration aforesaid further Leave therof to Imparle here untille the third Tuesday of March then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Isaiah here also &c.

All which day here came againe as well the aforesaid Isaiah Bredell as the aforesaid Wm. Gray by their attorney aforesaid and whereupon the same William defends the force and Injury wherof and saith that he did not assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the said Isaiah above against himselfe hath complained and of that he putt himselfe upon the Country — And after wards the same day last mentioned the said William Relinquisheth his Verification aforesaid by him above pretended, saith that that he cannot deny the act aforesaid of the said Isaiah nor but that he did assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the said Isaiah above against himselfe hath complained and as to the Damage of the same said by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same William saith and acknowledgeth that the aforesaid Isaiah hath sustained Damages by occasion of the premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part appoynted to him pounds One Shilling and Seven pence Curr. money of Maryland and not more and because the aforesaid Isaiah denyes not this but the same allegation believeth to be true prayeth Judgment for those Damages above acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges aforesaid to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid it is considered that the aforesaid Isaiah Bredell recover against the aforesaid William Gray his Damages aforesaid to the aforesaid from pounds One Shilling and Seven pence Curr. money of Maryland in full aforesaid acknowledged as also of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges aforesaid to the same Isaiah at his request by the Court here of the aforesaid of the parties aforesaid adjudged which said Damages in the whole do amount to four pounds One Shilling & Seven pence and pounds of Tobacco with stay of Execution untille the first day of June then next following &c.
