Therefore by Consent of the parties afo' it is Considered that the afo' Isaiah Bredell recover against the afo' William Gray his damages afo' to the afo' four pounds One Shilling and Seven pence curr. money of Maryland in form afo' acknowledged as also

of tobacco for his Costs and Charges afo' to the same Isaiah at his request by the Court here of the afo' of the parties afo' adjudged which certain damages in the whole do amount to four pounds One Shilling & Seven pence and ^{pounds} ^{one} pounds of tobacco with pay of the same until the first day of June then next following &
