Tobacco being due unto him for his attendance three days as an Evidence on behalfe of

Ordered that Joseph Botter Recover against Samuel Adams Ninety pounds of tobacco  
being due unto him for his attendance three days as an Evidence on behalfe of the said  
Samuel Adams against William Gray he having made oath to the same &c

Ordered that William Stephens Recover against John Evans four hundred and  
Twenty pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance fourteen days as an Evidence  
on be half of the said John Evans against Peter Taylor he having made oath to  
the same &c

Ordered that Henry Reynolds Recover against Abraham Owen Ninety pounds of  
tobacco being due unto him for his attendance three days as an Evidence on behalfe of  
the said Abraham Owen against Richard Hubbard he having made oath to the  
same &c

Ordered that Cap<sup>t</sup> Edward Rownd be allowed five pounds Curr<sup>t</sup> Money he so  
bringing in the best specie of Silver according to act of assembly in such case  
provided &c
