Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take James German late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November anno domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty six to answer unto John Atkinson of a plea of trespass upon the aforesaid and that the day of his trial should not fail him. At which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came the said John Atkinson by Francis Allen his attorney and the Sheriff of the same County here returned that he had taken the aforesaid Henry German whose body now at the day he had ready to answer the aforesaid John Atkinson of the aforesaid plea as to him it was commanded and the said Sheriff at the said day after solemnly called bring not in the body of the said Henry German according to the return of his writ aforesaid. Whereupon the said Sheriff to will Joseph M'Garter Gant by his ^{by the Court} attorney ^{and} to his said Lordships the Lord proprietor for his default aforesaid three shillings and four pence court money unless he the said Sheriff shall the said Henry German before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next following and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Atkinson to be at which day here before his said Lordships Justices at Dividing Creek came the said John Atkinson by his attorney aforesaid whereupon the said John declared against the aforesaid Henry in the plea aforesaid following.

Somerset County vs Henry German late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto John Atkinson of a plea of trespass upon the aforesaid
And Whereupon the said John by Francis Allen his attorney complains that whereas the said Henry the eleventh day of February anno domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty five was at the County of Somerset aforesaid within the jurisdiction of this Court indebted unto the said John in the sum of twenty three pounds five shillings and nine pence three farthings court money of Maryland for sundry proper chargeable in act as by act thereof hereunto annexed may in Court appear and being so thereof indebted the said Henry the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid in consideration thereof upon himself
