And whosoever on the said Henry Derman in his own proper person at the same day Cometh & defendeth the force & Injury when he doth saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the said John Aldison nor but that he did a purpose upon himself in manner and form as the said John above against him hath complained and as to the damages of the same done by him by reason of the premises in that part sustained the same Henry saith and acknowledgeth that the said John hath sustained damages by reason of the premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoyed to Nineteen pounds, Thirteen Shillings & Eleven pence three farthings Curr. money of Maryland and not more and because the said John denyeth not this but believes the same allegation to be true prays Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges aforesaid to him to be adjudged.

Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid it is considered that the said John shall receive against the said Henry Derman his damages aforesaid to the said Nineteen pounds, Thirteen Shillings & Eleven pence three farthings Curr. money of Maryland in form aforesaid acknowledged as also three hundred & thirty five pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges aforesaid to the said John at his request by the Court here of the aforesaid parties aforesaid adjudged which damages with the whole do amount to Nineteen pounds, Thirteen Shillings & Eleven pence three farthings Curr. money of Maryland & three hundred & thirty five pounds of tobacco & the said Henry in Warranty.
