The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Commissioner hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the Estate of Sarah Roach deceased wherein it is found that there is balance due to the above said orphans the sum of forty six pounds ten shillings and eight pence Court money therefor if the above said Sampson Wheatly his heirs Executors or administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above said orphans the aforesaid sum of forty six pounds ten shillings and eight pence Court money in equal parts and portions according to act of assembly when they shall arrive at full age to receive the same. Then the above obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and virtue it.
