here seen heard and fully understood it is considered by the Court her that the aforesaid Malatto Kate return  
to her Master William Colbourn Servant and that at the Expiration of her Service he return to the  
County Court of Somerset or Sheriff of the County to be brought to the said County what to be  
paid by to the several Officers for her fees due by mean of the premises aforesaid

The same County & the 10th day of November 1736. The Justices for the Right Honourable  
Mary Walker Proprietary that now is for the Body of Somerset County & on their oaths  
to present that Mary Walker late of Allhallows po in the County aforesaid  
Spinster the tenth day of November 1736. A.D. seventeen hundred and thirty six at the  
parish aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of the Court did commit fornication  
with a certain person to the Jurors of unknown and did permit the same unknown person  
therin and there to have carnal knowledge of her body and to beget them and there a bastard
