And afterwards the same third Tuesday of March to wit the fifteenth day of the same month
Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred & thirty six before the Indictment of his Lordships County
Court of Somerset now here held at the Court house at Dividing Creek in and for the same County
came the said Mary Walker in her proper person and had a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid and
being instantly demanded how she would acquit her self of the premises aforesaid above upon her
and made oath that certain John Whitehead is the begetter of the child she stands indicted for
I answered say that she is guilty thereof but hath not wherewithal to pay her fine for the fact aforesaid
Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard & fully understood

It is considered (the aforesaid Mary Walker being at the publick whipping post with
ten stripes on the Bear Bank well laid on while the blood appear and that she be taken up
and hang upon as to the corporal punishment aforesaid command it is given to the Sheriff of Somerset
County that he do thereof immediate Execution by whipping of the aforesaid Mary Walker at the
whipping post with ten stripes well laid on while the blood appeareth. And after-

the same Court saw the said aforesaid and made return to the same Court that he had done

The Judgment aforesaid as to the corporal punishment aforesaid he was commanded whereupon
the said Mary Walker is ordered to give Security for the payment of the several Officers
their fees due by reason of the premises aforesaid or the Indictment aforesaid. Thereupon a certain Abraham
Smith present herein to him in his proper person undertook for the said Mary Walker and acknowledged
himself indebted unto his Lordships the Right wuble the Lord Proprietor of the province of
Maryland in his sum office one hundred pounds of tobacco of his goods and chattels to be made & levied
to the use of the several Officers of Somerset County and that he shall alight to any fee or fees on
the Indictment aforesaid against the said Mary Walker, In case the said Mary Walker do not pay
and satisfy unto the aforesaid Officers the fee or fees due aforesaid otherwise the said Mary
Walker is ordered to give Security for her appearance in order to give witness on behalf of his Lordship.

Thereupon the aforesaid Abraham Smith present here

selfe to be indebted unto his said Lordships the Lord
Proprietor of his goods and chattels Lands and encumbrances in
his right and title if it happen that the said Mary
Walker shall appear here in Court from day to day and every day
as she shall know on behalf of his said Lordship
do depart the same Court without leave to accord
from day to day and every day of his term in order
said Abraham Smith is discharged from the fee
