The above actions were entered agreed on the 11<sup>th</sup> of May  
 Docket for Manch Court anno Dom. 1736.

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take  
 John Bishop late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his  
 bailly wick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices  
 of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing creek in the same County the third  
 Tuesday of March then next to satisfie unto Lilliton Townsend of two thousand eight hundred  
 and twenty three pounds of tobacco which to the same Lilliton in the same Court before the said  
 Justices aforesaid was adjudged for his damage which he had by invasion of a certain pro-  
 perty and assumption to the same Lilliton by the act made and not performed whereof he  
 was grieved. All which say here came before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset at  
 dividing creek same the said Lilliton Townsend in his proper person and the Sheriff of the County did to wit  
 Joseph M... Master here returned that he had taken the said John Bishop who... body here at this day for his  
 ready as by the writ of the Court commanded him.
