Thereupon the said Charles Curtis with Thomas Beacham and John Tull of Division Neck of Somerset County planters are present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the said Grace Handy in the sum of One hundred pounds Current money of Maryland of their several bodies goods and Chattels Lands and tenements jointly and severally to be made & levied to the use of the said Grace Handy her heirs or assigns.
