County Court ... here in Court undertakes for the said Hannah Bartlett and acknowledged himself indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco of his body goods or Chattels Lands and tenements to be made & Levied to the use of the severall Officers belonging to Somerset County Court that hath or shall be liable to any fee or fees on the Inditment of by means of the premises. In case the said Hannah Bartlett do not pay & Satisfie unto the severall Officers of their fee or fees as aforesaid by reason of the premises aforesaid. Likewise the said Hannah Bartlett is ordered to give security for to save & keep Indemnified the Justice of Somerset County & their Successors from all Costs Charges & troubles that might arise by means of the birth of the said Child.

Whereupon the said William Turpin present here in Court as aforesaid undertook for the said Hannah Bartlett and acknowledged himself indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland in the sum of forty pounds sterling of his goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to the use of the Justice of Somerset & their Successors to be made and Levied. If it happen that the said Hannah Bartlett her heirs Executors or Administrators or any of them do & shall not from time to time and at all times hereafter discharge and save himself as well the Justice of Somerset County of and their Successors being as also the Inhabitants of the said County, of and from all Costs Charges and troubles, or by reason of the birth, maintenance, nourishing and bringing up of the said Child, & of Sutes, Charges, troubles, and expenses whatsoever touching or concerning of the same.

This Somerset County J^r Beil remembered that William Godborough Gent^l Attorney for the Right Honourable Lord Proprietary that now is who for the same. James Anderson Esq^r Attorney in this part present doth come here into the County Court of the said Lord Proprietary he for Somerset County to wit at dividing Creek in the County of the fifteen day of March Anno Domini seventeen hundred thirty six before John Smith Esq^r and his Associates the said Lord Proprietary his Justices of the same County Court and for the same Lord Proprietary doth give and be informed that James Anderson Esq^r of Somerset last day of June Anno Domini seventeen hundred thirty six and within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and against George Gale of the same County Gent^l in the peace of being with force and Arms an assault did make on him did beat wound and evilly treat so that of his life it was in him then and there did to the great damage of the same King of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good Pleas the same Attorney of the said Lord Proprietary for the Advice of the Court here in the premises and that the said James Anderson may be made to answer.
