and wear during the term aforesaid etc —

John Dordine John Dordine (son of Aaron Dordine late of Somerset County deceased) an orphan of his own
borned to free Consent is bound out by the Court here an apprentice according to act of assembly in
Henry Ballard. such as provided unto Henry Ballard of the same County gent while he arrives at the
age of Twenty One Years he being then Years of age last March the said John Dordine to serve his said
Master the full term aforesaid during which term the said John Dordine his said Master well and faithfully shall
serve his valets keep his Commandments lawfully and honestly every where willingly he shall do and in
all things as a good and faithful apprentice he shall demean himself towards his said Master and all his
during the term aforesaid In consideration of which Service the said Henry Ballard present herein
Com in his proper person covenanteth with the Justices of the same Court in Court judicially
Sitting in manner and form following wit that he the said Henry Ballard during his term aforesaid shall
and will Learn his said apprentice either the trade of a Black Smith or Cordwainer and
give him during the same term One whole Year half Schooling, and also a suit of Cloathes at the Expi-
ration of his servitude and ane suit of Cloathes over and above his common Wearing Cloathes and
Likewise find and provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Clothing meet for such
an apprentice to have & wear during the term aforesaid — Wherupon the said Henry Ballard is ordered to
give Recouerance for the performing of the covenant aforesaid Thereupon the said Henry Ballard present herein
in his proper person acknowledged himself indebted unto the said John Dordine in the sum of Thirty
pounds Sterling gold & Lawfull money of England of his body goods or Chattells Lands or tenements to the use
of the said John Dordine his heirs or assigns ^{to be made & levied} if it happen that the said Henry Ballard do not during the
term aforesaid Learn his said apprentice the trade either of a Black Smith, or Cordwainer, and do not give him ^{one} whole
Year & half Schooling, and do not at the Expiration of his servitude give him ane suit of Cloathes over and
above his common Wearing Cloathes and also a suit of Cloathes, and Likewise find and provide for his said
apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Clothing meet for such an apprentice to have & wear during
the term aforesaid
