Right honorable the Lord Proprietary for her fine by the Court here upon her imposed for and by  
Occasion of the premises aforesaid whereof in form aforesaid she is convicted thirty Shillings Curr. Money of Mary-  
land (to the Use of the County aforesaid) and that the said Mary Glover be taken to satisfy his said Lordship  
of the fine aforesaid. — Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the said Mary Glover give  
Security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due by means of the Inditment aforesaid &  
Thereupon a certain David Cordery of Somerset County planter present before the Court in his proper-  
person undertakes for the said Mary Glover, and acknowledged himselfe indebted unto his Lordship the  
Lord Proprietary in the sum of five hundred pounds of Tobacco of his body goods or Chattell Land  
and Tenements for the Use of the severall Officers that hath right to any fee or fees on the Inditment  
aforesaid by means of the premises aforesaid. In case the said Mary Glover doe and shall not pay and  
Satisfie unto the severall Officers their Just fee or fees, as aforesaid by means of the premises aforesaid on the  
Inditment aforesaid. Likewise the said Mary Glover is ordered to give Security to save &  
Keep Endamaged the Justices of Somerset County and their Successors from all Costs Charges  
and Burthens that might arise by means of the birth of the Child aforesaid —

Whereupon the said Mary Glover with the said David Cordery her Security both present  
herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord-  
Proprietary in thirty pounds Sterling gold and Lawfull money of England of their body goods &  
Chattell Lands and Tenements to the Use of the Justices of the County aforesaid and their Successors to  
be made and Levied if it happen that the said Mary Glover her Heirs Executors or Administrators  
or any of them doe and shall not from time <sup>to time</sup> and at all times hereafter acquitt discharge  
and save harmless as well the Justices of Somerset County aforesaid and their Successors for the  
time being as also the Inhabitants of the said County of and from all Costs Charges troubles  
and Incumbrances whatsoever for or by reason of the Birth maintenance nourishing and  
bringing up of the said Child and of and from all other Suits Charges troubles and demands  
what soever touching or concerning of the same &c.
