He cannot deny but that he is guilty of the premises as<sup>d</sup> in the Indictment specified in manner  
and form as by the Indictment as<sup>d</sup> above against him supposed, and the premises as<sup>d</sup>  
expressly acknowledgeth: but hath not wherewithal to pay his fine for the same off but putt himself  
upon the favour of the Court. Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood  
It is considered that the said John Whitehead be whiped at the publick whipping post at Dwidging Creek for the County  
as with five stripes on the Bare back well laid on while his blood appear and that the said John Whitehead be -  
taken &c. And whereupon as to the corporall punishment as<sup>d</sup> command is given to the Sheriff of Somersel County  
that he do therof immediate Execution by whipping of the said John Whitehead at the publick whipping post with -  
five stripes on the Bare back well laid on while the blood appear it being adjudged Satisfaction for the  
Offence as<sup>d</sup> &c. and afterwards in the same Court came the said Sheriff and returned that he had done the  
Execution of the Judgment as<sup>d</sup> as to the corporall punishment as<sup>d</sup> he was commanded &c. and forasmuch as it appears  
to the Court here that the said John Whitehead is a servant to a Captain John Headold Jr. whereinon the said John Whitehead  
is remanded by the Court to his said masters service &c.

same County committed to hear and determine asigned by the oath of Alexander Lack  
ie a dwelue others being presented that Sarah Thomson late of Somersel parish in the  
County as<sup>d</sup> Spurster the first day of March anno Dom<sup>r</sup> seventeen hundred thirty and six  
at the parish as<sup>d</sup> in the County as<sup>d</sup> within the jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornic-  
ation with a certain person to the shew as<sup>d</sup> unknown and did permit the same to  
unknown person then and to have carnal knowledge of her body and to beget then and  
there a basterd child on the body of her the same Sarah to the high displeasure of al-  
mighty god to the evil example of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of  
the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good Rule and Government and against the sum  
of the act of assembly in such case lately made and provided &c. By which it was command-  
ed the Sheriff of Somersel County that he shoul<sup>r</sup> take the said Sarah Thomson late of Somersel  
parish if she should be found in his bailey wch and her shoul<sup>r</sup> safe keep so that he might have
