Whereupon a certain John Shelton of the County of Kent present here in Court undertook for the said Eleanor Mahony and acknowledged himself bound unto his Lordship the right honorable the Lord Proprietary in the sum of thirty pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of his body goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to the use of the Justices aforesaid and their Deputies to be made and Levied. If it happen that the said Eleanor Mahony her heirs Executors & Administrators or any of them do and shall not from time to time and at all times hereafter acquit discharge save harmless as well the Justices of Somerset County aforesaid and their Deputies for the time being as also the Inhabitants of the said County of and from all Costs Charges troubles and Inconveniences whatsoever for or by reason of the birth maintenance Nourishing and bringing up of the said Child and of and from all other Suits Charges troubles and demands what soever touching or concerning of the same &c.

Whereupon at the prayer of George Darhick of Somerset County Gent on behalf of William Dulany Master of the said Eleanor Mahony, for to make him satisfaction for the trouble & Charge he was at in the time of her the said Eleanor Mahony's lying in, and for the expenses and Charges on the Judgment aforesaid and upon mature deliberation by the Court on the premises had &c. The said Eleanor Mahony is adjudged by the Court here to serve the said William Dulany his heirs or assigns the full term of one whole year and a halfe to commence from the day of the date of these presents which said year & a halfe shall be so as is adjudged by the Court is deemed to be full satisfaction for all Costs Charges & troubles that the said William Dulany was at, at the time of the said Eleanor Mahony's lying in, as also for all the Costs and Charges on the prosecution above &c.
