These upon command was given to the Sheriffs of Somerset County that he should take the said James Anderson if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might we his body before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the Court house in or for the same County the third Tuesday of March than to answer unto his Lordship's Court concerning an assault by him made &c. and that thereof he should not fail &c. And afterwards the third Tuesday of March to wit the fifteenth day of the same month and Dow. One thousand seven hundred and thirty six before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset now here held in the Court house at Dividing Creek in and for the same County came the said James Anderson in his proper person and had hearing of the Information aforesaid and being instantly demanded how he would answer himself of the trespass and assault aforesaid as by the Information upon him imposed, saith that he is guilty thereof &c. Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood &c.

It is considered that the said James Anderson pay unto his said Lordship the sum of £100 for and by reason of trespass and assault aforesaid and that the said James Anderson be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the said sum of £100 pursuant by Francis Porter his Deputy &c.

Whereupon the said Nathaniel Brittingham's appearance is recorded & he and his security accordingly discharged &c. Likewise after Thomas Landen (at whose instance the said Nathaniel had been bound) being here in Court say that the said Nathaniel may be continued bound and for that purpose the Court of the peace in common form &c. Nathaniel Brittingham is ordered to give new security for his good behaviour the next time he shall be here in Court &c. Nathaniel Brittingham with Francis Porter of Somerset County planter his security person acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship's Court in the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling each good and lawful Land and tenements goods and chattels of such of them to the amount to be made and paid if it happen that the said Nathaniel shall make appearance before the Justices of his said Lordship's County at Dividing Creek in and for the same County the third Tuesday of
