Whereupon command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said James Anderson if he should be found in his baileywick and him should safe keep so that he might see his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the Court house in & for the same County the third Tuesday of March then to answer unto his Lordship <sup>near</sup> and concerning an assault by him made &c and that thereof he should not fail &c - And afterwards the <sup>same</sup> Tuesday of March to wit the fifteenth day of the same Month and Year One thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty Six before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here held in <sup>the</sup> County house at Dividing Creek in and for the same County & cause the said James Anderson in his proper person and had a hearing of the Information affd and being instantly demanded how he would aye <sup>for</sup> himself of the trespass and assault &c above as by the Information upon him Imposed, saith that he is Guilty thereof &c - Whereupon all and Singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood &c

It is considered that the said James Anderson pay unto his said Lordship the sum of Two Pounds Proprietary of the province of Maryland for his fine by the Court here upon him for and by reason of trespass and assault &c in sum afft he is convicted fine, & to pay Current money of Maryland and that the said James Anderson be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the sum afft. Shoo present by Francis Porter his Deputy &c

In this Lordship Nathaniel Brittingham late of Somerset County planter gentleman in his proper person according to a certaine warrant by him and his security before acknowledge and prayes that his appearance may be hearded & he & his security discharged & thengon & in Nathaniel Brittingham's appearance is hearded & he and his security accordingly discharged & Likewise after Thomas Landen (at whose instance the said Nathaniel had been bound) coming herin Court & say that the said Nathaniel may be continued bound of the peace & common frind & in Brittingham is Ordered to give now security for his good behaviour & honest & in Brittingham with Francis Porter of Somerset County planter his attorney & per persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship in the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling each good and law Land and tenement goods and chattels, of all of them to the best to be made and paid if it happen that the said Nathaniel shall appear before the Justices of his said Lordship County Dividing Creek in and for the same County the third Tuesday of
