The Condition of the above obligation is such that Where as the
 said Nehemiah Nock hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the Estate of Benj^r
 Walton where in it is found that there is ball^d due to the abovesaid orphans the
 sum of seven pounds eight shillings and two pence Curt. money therefore if
 said Nehemiah Nock his heirs Ex^r or adm^r shall and do well and truly

pay or cause to be paid unto the abovesaid orphans the aforesaid sum of thirty seven
 pounds sixteen shillings and two pence Curt. money to be paid here according
 to Act of Assembly when he shall arrive at full age to receive the same &c. Then
 the above obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force
