in the 21<sup>st</sup> Year of our Domini Christi Anno Domini 1735 On the fraying Commission it was  
Endorsed 2<sup>nd</sup> March the 20<sup>th</sup> 1736 came before Francis Allen John Henry and John Sheldon Esqrs  
the subscriber and was duly Qualified to execute the within Commission according to the di-  
rections of an Act of Assembly in that Case made sworn before me - James Martin -

The Execution of the within Commission appears in certain depositions to the same  
Anno 1735 - Annexed so Answers - Francis Allen & Sheldon - Somerset County Esqrs  
Deposition of Witnesses taken In Relation to the bounds of part of a tract of Land -  
Called the Golden Lyon on the behalf of Solomon Rigger by virtue of a Commission to  
us whose names are hereunder written directed by the Worshipfull the Justices of  
Somerset County Court bearing date the twentieth day of March Anno Domini One thousand  
and seven hundred and thirty five we being first duly sworn according to Law -

Commod Dickerson gent of Somerset County planter aged fifty years or there-  
abouts being sworn on the holy evangelist of almighty God by us the said Commissioners  
deposeth and saith that upon the point of an Oyster shell Hammock wherein he now  
stands within twenty foot of a cedar tree Blown down stood the first bounder of a tract  
of Land Called the golden Lyon and that verily Believes the same cedar tree now blown  
down to be the first bounder of the tract of Land called the golden Lyon and that upon  
Teague Rigger the elder his taking up of a tract of Land containing one hundred acre  
Called Rigger's mine (as he is informed) he was present at the survey and they began  
to run their course from the said first bounder cedar tree and further saith not  
Teague Donchier of Somerset County planter aged fifty Commod <sup>his</sup> Dickerson  
years or thereabouts being sworn on the holy evangelist of almighty God by us the  
said Commissioners deposeth and saith that upon the point as near to the tree  
that Commod Dickerson hath worn to his father in law Teague Rigger son of  
Teague Rigger the elder informed him (within twenty foot of cedar tree worn to  
by Commod Dickerson) the first bounder of the tract of Land called the golden Lyon and  
further saith not Teague Donchier -

Teague Rigg of Somerset County planter aged forty years or thereabouts being -  
sworn on the holy evangelist of almighty God by us the said Commissioners deposeth and
