

June Court - - - - 1737 - - - - 69

The name of Mr. Thos. Burnall or his assigns fifteen hundred and forty pounds of tobacco  
at three different payments vizt. Five hundred pounds of tobacco on the first day of May  
and D<sup>r</sup> seventeen hundred and three five hundred pounds more of the like tobacco  
on the first day of June and D<sup>r</sup> seventeen hundred and thirty six and one four hundred  
and forty pounds of tobacco on the twenty fifth day of June and D<sup>r</sup> seventeen hundred  
and thirty seven by means whereof said by force of the Statute in that Case made and  
provided the afo<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> became chargeable to pay to the said Thomas the afo<sup>r</sup> Quantity  
of tobacco according to the tenor of the said note and being so thereof chargeable on consid-  
eration whereof afterward to wit on the said twenty fifth day of June A<sup>d</sup> D<sup>r</sup> seventeen  
hundred thirty and four at Somerset County upon himself did promise and to the same  
Thomas then and there faithfully promise that he the said W<sup>m</sup> the afo<sup>r</sup> quantity of fifteen  
hundred and forty pounds of tobacco according to the tenor of the said note well and faithfully  
he would pay and content Nevertheless left the said William his promise and assumption of  
in fact afo<sup>r</sup> made nothing regarding but minding and fraudulently intending the said  
Thomas in that part hastily and subtlely to deceive and defraud the said quantity of  
fifteen hundred and forty pounds of tobacco according to the tenor of the said note or any part  
thereof to the said Thos. hath not paid or bin for the same in any sort contented but the same or any  
part thereof to him to pay hitherto hath refused and still refuse all the quantity of five hundred  
pounds of tobacco on the second day of May A<sup>d</sup> D<sup>r</sup> seventeen hundred thirty and four at Somerset  
County and also the quantity of other five hundred pounds of tobacco on the second day of June  
A<sup>d</sup> D<sup>r</sup> seventeen hundred thirty and six at the County of - and often afterward to pay to the said  
Thos. Burnall the said W<sup>m</sup> was required whereupon the said Thos. Burnall saffid I am myself  
three thousand pounds of tobacco and those he brings will be — Bledgdon & J. Dose Esqrs

A copy of the foregoing Declaration was made and sent to be served on the said William Wye  
with his writ and according to act of Assembly in such case provided.

All which day here before his Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset dividing each case  
the said Thomas Burnall by his attorney afo<sup>r</sup> and Notchife of the same County to wit Joseph Myddel-  
ton at the same day here returned that he had taken the afo<sup>r</sup> William Wye whose body lay at his  
day he had ready to answer the afo<sup>r</sup> Thomas Burnall of the afo<sup>r</sup> place as to him it was commanded and  
likewise that he had served the afo<sup>r</sup> William Wye with a copy of the afo<sup>r</sup> Declaration according to act of  
Assembly
