At which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at dividing Creech
Came the a^s Samuel Beekley by Geo: Douglas his attorney and the Sheriff of the same County
to wit Joseph M^{re} Esq: or Gent. at the same day here returned that he had taken the a^s
Abraham Ingram whose body at this day he had ready to answer the a^s Samuel Beekley
of the a^s plea as to him it was commanded. And whereupon the a^s Abraham Ingram
by Francis Allen his attorney came here before the a^s Justices and prayed that the a^s
Samuel Beekley may give Security for Costs according to Act of Assembly in such case made
provided in case he be nominated in the plea a^s which by the Court granted thereupon Geo:
Douglas of Somerset, Esq: or Gent. present herein Court in his proper person undertakes
for the said Samuel Beekley that if in case he be nominated in the plea a^s otherwise
legally cast that then he the said Samuel Beekley shall pay the Judgment of the Court
and all Costs arriving thereon to the said Abraham Ingram or that he the said George
Douglas will do the same for him.

Whereupon at the Request of the parties day is given to the parties a^s here before his
Lordships Justices untill the third Tuesday of Aug: then next following in the date where
in they now are saving to the parties a^s At which day before his Lordships
Justices here came as well the a^s Samuel as the a^s Abraham by their attorneys a^s and at
the request of the parties a^s further day is given to the parties a^s in the plea a^s here untill the
third Tuesday of November then next following in the date where in they now are saving to the
parties a^s And hereupon the said Samuel Beekley declared against the said Abra: Ingram
in form following: Somerset s^t Abraham Ingram late of Somerset County planter
was attached to answer unto Samuel Beekley of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c
And whereupon the said Samuel by Geo: Douglas his attorney, explains that
whereas the said Abraham on the twenty third day of October Anno Dom: seventeen
hundred and thirty three at the County of Somerset a^s within the Jurisdiction
of this Court was indebted to the said Samuel in the sum of twenty pounds five shillings
and four pence half penny s^t money of Maryland for sundry goods wares and merch:
and so by the said Samuel to the said Abraham at the especial Instance and request
of the said Abraham before that time sold and delivered and so being thereof Indebted
on Consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year a^s at the County a^s
