 here also — All which day here came againe as well the af<sup>o</sup> Samuel Beekley as the  
 af<sup>o</sup> Abraham Ingram by their attorney af<sup>o</sup> and whereupon the same Abraham as  
 before defends the force and injury when<sup>t</sup> and saith that he did not assume upon himself  
 in manner and form as the said Samuel above against him hath complained and of this he puts  
 himself upon the Country &c — And the af<sup>o</sup> Abraham prays that the af<sup>o</sup> Samuel  
 may reply to the plea of the same Abraham and afterward the same Samuel altho' sol-  
 :mely called cometh not to the plea of the same <sup>him</sup> Abraham replyeth nor is his writt af<sup>o</sup> against  
 the said <sup>him</sup> further prosecuted — Therefore it is considered that the af<sup>o</sup> Samuel  
 Beekley take nothing by his writt af<sup>o</sup> but that he and his pledges of prosecuting  
 to wit John Doe and Richard Roe be in mercy and that the af<sup>o</sup> Abraham as goe  
 thereof without day &c and further it is considered that the af<sup>o</sup> Abraham recover  
 against the af<sup>o</sup> Samuel Beekley: Two hundred & sixteen  
 256 — — — : pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges by him about his defence  
 af<sup>o</sup> in that part sustained to the same Abraham Ingram by the Court here according  
 the form of the Statute in such case lately made and provided as judged and that the same  
 Abraham have thereof Execution &c
