Boston money and five hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June Next then and there to be Condemned according to Act of Assembly to and for the use of a certain Samuel Hopkins unless the said John Donelson by himself for his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Samuel Hopkins in a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. According to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to Act of Assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this Writt that you make hereunto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this writt with witness John Smith Gent. one of our Justices of our said Court the twentyeth day of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty five

All which day here came the said Samuel Hopkins by George Douglas his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to witt Joseph M^r Clerk Gent at the same day returned the writt aforesaid following viz. By virtue of the within Writt to me directed to the Justices within mentioned I Certifie that I have on the fourteenth day of June attached in the hands of William Whittington of the goods and Chattels light and Credits of Capt John Donelson for the use of Capt Samuel Hopkins to the value of fifteen pounds Curr. Money and I further Certifie that by John Doe and Richard Roe good and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick that ^{he} be and appear at the time and place within contained to show for

And the said William Whittington has shew as aforesaid by Francis Allen his attorney Comer and defend the force and Injury whereof and prayeth Leave that ^{next Court to be hold at dividing Creek} he may have the third Tuesday of August then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the said Samuel Hopkins also &c.

All which day here came againe as well the said Samuel Hopkins as the said William Whittington by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the same William Whittington prayes further Leave that of to ^{next Court to be hold at dividing Creek} Imparls hereunto the third Tuesday of November then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the said Samuel Hopkins also &c.
