Boston money and five hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof
the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court
of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater next the third Tuesday of June Next Then and thereto be
condemned according to Act of Assembly to and for the use of a certain Samuel Hopkins
unless the said John Donelson by himself or his attorney shall appear and answer
unto the said Samuel Hopkins in a plea of res ipsa upon the case &c According to Law
and that by good and Lawfull men of our County which you make known unto the person
or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear
before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to show cause if any he she or they
have why the same goods chattels rights or credits so attached in his her or their hands
ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to act of Assembly
(in such case made and provided) if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you
shall execute this Writ that you make return unto our said Justices at the day and
place aforesaid and have you then and therewith witness John Smith Gent one of our
Justices of our said Court the twenty sixth day of March Anno Domini one thousand seven
hundred and thirty five.

All which day here came the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins by George Douglas his attorney and the
Sheriff of Somerset County to will Joseph M'Glashen Gent at the same day returned the writ aforesaid
following vizt. By virtue of the within Writ to me directed to the Justices within
mentioned I Certifie that I have on the fourteenth day of June attached in the hands of William
Whittington of the goods and chattells right and credits of Capt John Donelson for the use of Capt
Samuel Hopkins to the value of fifteen pounds curr. Money and I further Certifie that by John
Doe and Richard Roe good and Lawfull men of my County which ^{he} said appears at the
time and place within contained to show for.

And the said William Whittington garnishee as aforesaid by Francis Allen his attorney comes and defend
the same and Injury whereof and prayeth leave ^{next Court to be held at Bridgwater} to Imparle hereupon the third Tuesday
of August then next following and he hath it givn to the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins also aforesaid

All which day here came again as well the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins as the aforesaid William Whittington
by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the same William Whittington pray further leave to be
^{next Court to be held at Bridgwater} Imparle hereupon the third Tuesday of November then next following and he hath it and the same
day is given to the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins also aforesaid

All which day here came again as well the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins as the aforesaid William Whittington
