And Whereupon the said Benj^d by Rob^t Jenkins Henry his attorney complains that where
 as the afo^r Thomas in his lifetime (to witt) the tenth day of January in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred thirty and five at Somerset County afo^r within the jurisdiction of this
 Court was indebted to the Benj^d in the sum of four pounds fourteen shillings and six pence
 Court money of Maryland for sundry Articles properly chargeable in an account (as by
 an Account there of heretofore Court thought may appear) and thereof being indebted
 the same Thomas in his lifetime (to witt) the day and year afo^r at the place afo^r in Consider
 ation thereof upon himself did assume and to the said Benj^d then and there did faithfully
 promise that he the said Thomas the afo^r four pounds fourteen shillings and six pence
 unto the said Benj^d when he should afterwards thereunto requested he would well and faith
 fully pay and Content and altho' the said Thomas in his lifetime one pound six shillings and seven
 pence part of the afo^r four pounds fourteen shillings and six pence to the said Benj^d he since
 paid and satisfied NEVER the less to three pounds seven shillings and eleven pence thereof resi
 due the said Thomas in his lifetime and the afo^r Mary since the decease of the afo^r Thomas
 the promise and assumption of the said Thomas in his lifetime so as afo^r made nothing regarding
 but plotting and fraudulently intending the said Benj^d in that part craftily and subtilly
 subtilly to deceive and defraud the said three pounds seven shillings and eleven pence Court money
 afo^r to the said Benj^d hath not paid nor either of them hath paid or Contented altho' the same Tho^s
 in his lifetime (to witt) on the eleventh day of February Anno Domⁱ seventeen hundred thirty and
 five and often afterwards and the said Mary since the decease of the said Thomas (to witt) on the twelfth
 day of July in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred thirty and six and often since that time at
 Somerset County afo^r was thereunto requested by him the said Benj^d but the same to the said
 to pay the said Thomas in his lifetime did refuse and the same to the said Benj^d to pay the said
 Mary doth still refuse and deny therefore the said Benj^d that he is the worse and hath damage to
 the value of seven pounds Court money of the province afo^r and thereupon he brings suit &c
