Court house at Bridgwater hek<sup>t</sup> and for the same County came the said Charles Mumford in his proper  
person according to a certain Recognizance by him and his Security before acknowledged  
and pray that his appearance may be Recorded and he and his Security discharged & there-  
upon the same Charles Mumford appearance is Recorded and he and his Security accordingly  
discharged from the Recognizance a<sup>p</sup>

Whereupon the same Charles Mumford ordered to give Security for the payment of the  
several officers their fee or fees due by means of the Recognizance and Indictmt a<sup>p</sup> &c There-  
upon a certain William Mumford of Somersel County planter present herein bound in his  
proper person indentor for the same Charles Mumford and acknowledged himself Indebted

to be made and levied in case the said Charles Mumford doth not pay and satisfie to the  
all officers of their Due fees due as aforesaid

Collier John Holloway and Joseph Holloway ale severally appear here in Court bound  
in their Recognizances to give evidence on behalf of his Lordships against the said  
Charles Mumford and are accordingly discharged therefrom &c
