And the afo John Apon in his own proper person Cometh and defendanteth the force  
and injury wher he and prayeth leave therof to Imparte here until the third Tuesday  
of November then next and hath it and the same day is given to the afo Mathias  
here also. At which day here came againe as well the afo Mathias Hale ~~also~~  
~~as~~ by his attorney afo as the afo John Apon in his proper person, and wherupon  
the same John pray further leave therof to Imparte here until the third Tuesday  
of March then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the afo  
Mathias <sup>here</sup> also.

At which day here came againe the said Mathias Hale by his attorney afo  
and pray that the same John Apon to his declaration afo may answer. But the same  
John says nothing in bar or preclusion of the action afo of the afo Mathias by which  
the same Mathias remaineth against the afo John thereof undefended - for which the same  
Mathias his damages by occasion of the non performance of the promise and assumption afo ag.  
the same John Ought to recover but because it is not known unto the Justices of his Lord-  
ships County Court of Somerset where what damages the same Mathias in that part hath sustain-  
ed therefore it is commanded the Sheriff that by the Oath of honest and Lawfull men of his County  
he diligently Enquire what damages the same Mathias hath sustained as well by occasion  
of the non performance of the promise and assumption afo as for his Costs and Charges by him  
about his suit in that part apposed and the Inquisition which wherupon he should take he  
make appear to the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held in the Court house  
at Dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of June then next following under his  
seal and the Seals of those by whose oaths he take that same Inquisition he send together with his  
Lordships writ therof to him directed and the same day is given to the afo Mathias there for  
all which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek  
came the afo Mathias Hale by his attorney afo and the Sheriff with Joseph Manchester Gent  
returned a certain Inquisition before him at the house of Thomas Dashille in Whitehaven Town  
in the County afo on the ninth day of April One thousand Seven hundred and thirty seven by  
the Oath of honest and Lawfull men of his County taken by which it is found that the afo  
Mathias hath sustained damages by occasion of the non performance of the promise  
assumption afo to Twenty seven pounds six shillings and six pence curr. money of Maryland  
Therefore it is considered that the afo Mathias Hale Recover against the afo John  
Apon his damages afo by his Inquisition afo found also <sup>572</sup> One thousand two hundred and
