right ought to be duly executed Wee Commaund you that by honest and lawfull men of  
your barlywick you make known to the afo Henry Miles that he be and appear  
before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creech in the  
County afo the third Tuesday of March next to shew cause if any thing for himself he hath  
or to say knoweth wherefore the afo Wm Colebourn his Execution of the debt and  
damages afo to have ought not according to the form of the Recovery afo if to him  
it seemeth Expedient and have you there the Names of those before whom to him you  
make known and this writt Witness Robert King gent. Chief Justice of our said  
Court the 22<sup>o</sup> day of December in the twenty second year of our Dominion G. Anno  
Dom one thousand seven hundred and thirty six

All which day before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at divid-  
ing Creech Cometh the afo William Colebourn by Francis Allen his attorney and the  
the Sheriff of the County afo to witte Joseph M. Porter gent. at the same day returned that  
by virtue of the writt afo to him directed he had made known unto the afo Henry Miles  
by Francis Porter and John Doe honest and Lawfull men of his Barlywick that  
he be. before his Lordships Justices at the day and place afo to show &c. as within to  
him it was Commaunded. and whereupon the afo William prays Execution against the afo Henry  
of the debt and damages afo in form afo to him to be adjudged &c. and the afo Henry Miles by  
William Buckingham his attorney Cometh and prayeth Leave thereof to impare hereuntil the  
third Tuesday of June then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the afo  
William here also &c.

All which day to witte the third Tuesday of June Cometh as well  
the afo William Colebourn as the afo Henry Miles by their attorneys afo and whereupon  
the said William as before prays Execution against the afo Henry of the debt & Damages  
afo to him to be adjudged &c. and the said Henry on the same day altho. solemnly called  
Cometh not. . . Therefore it is considered that the afo William Colebourn have  
Execution against the afo Henry Miles of the debt and damages afo by the said Henry's default
